

Resolution
by the South Carolina Libertarian Party

WHEREAS, the catchphrase of the Libertarian Party is “Minimum Government – Maximum Freedom”; and

WHEREAS, as Libertarians we support the inherent right of all people to self-determination, and to the establishment of such governance structures and social institutions as to them may seem most effective for preserving, promoting and protecting their individual liberty, happiness and property; and

WHEREAS, the research project known as “Marinea” is dedicated to the creation of a series of independent, self-sustaining, expandable and replicable “villages at sea”, beyond the territorial boundaries of any existing nation-state, in which like-minded individuals would be able to live and work free of the political dictates of oppressive national governments; and

WHEREAS, the ultimate goal of Marinea is the establishment *de novo* of sovereign nations organized on such governing principles at their residents may determine; and

WHEREAS, such a project is wholly consistent with Libertarian principles and ideals;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the South Carolina Libertarian Party does officially recognize and endorse the Marinea project, and encourages its members, friends and supporters to lend their support to Marinea in such manner as to them may seem appropriate and feasible, which support could include contributing financially, providing personal services, becoming a resident of any village at sea which may be established, or merely offering encouragement and moral support to the project; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the said Marinea project, and its promoters, officers, employees and members, are hereby authorized to refer to this Resolution on its website and in such of its news releases and other promotional materials as to them may seem appropriate.
